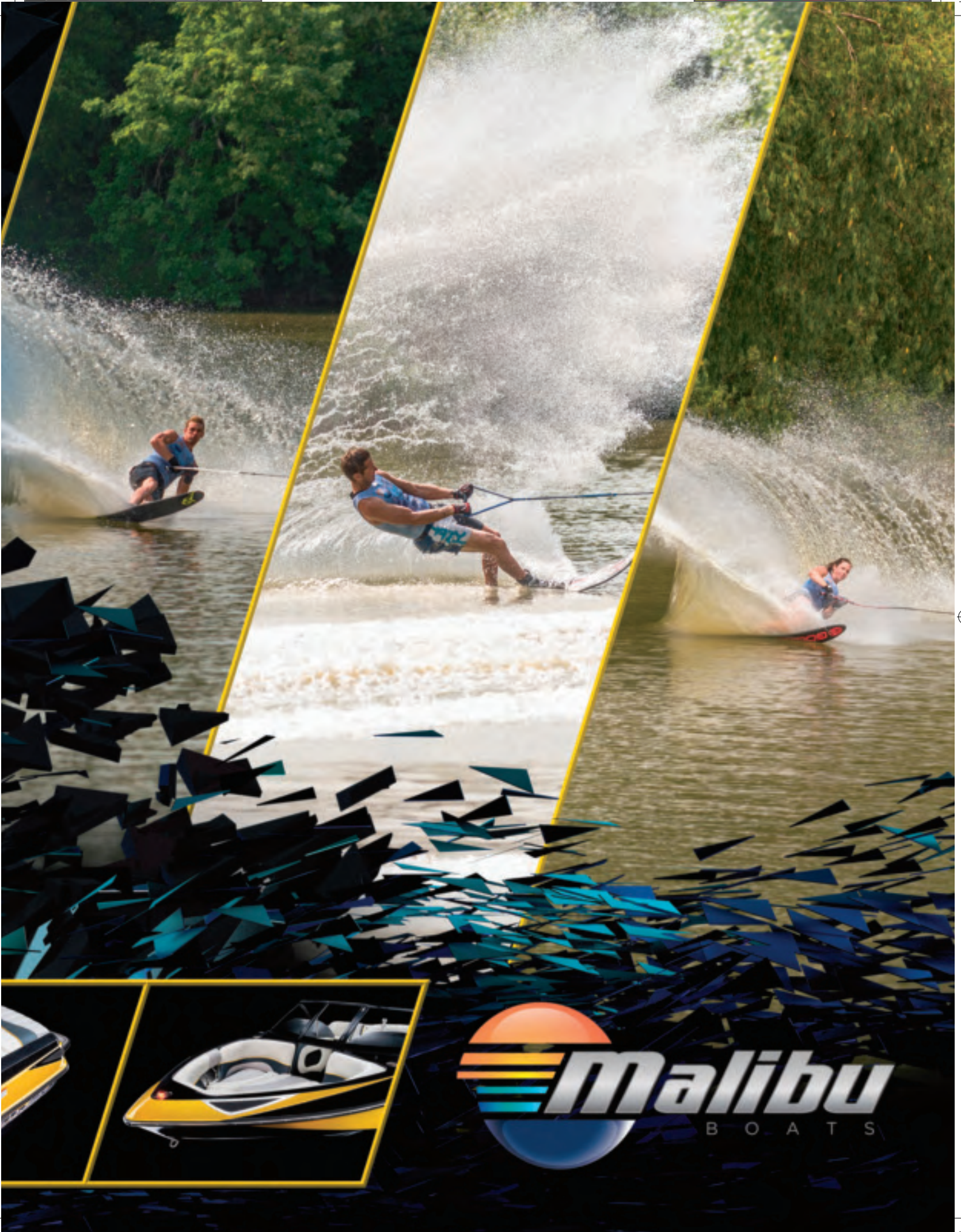

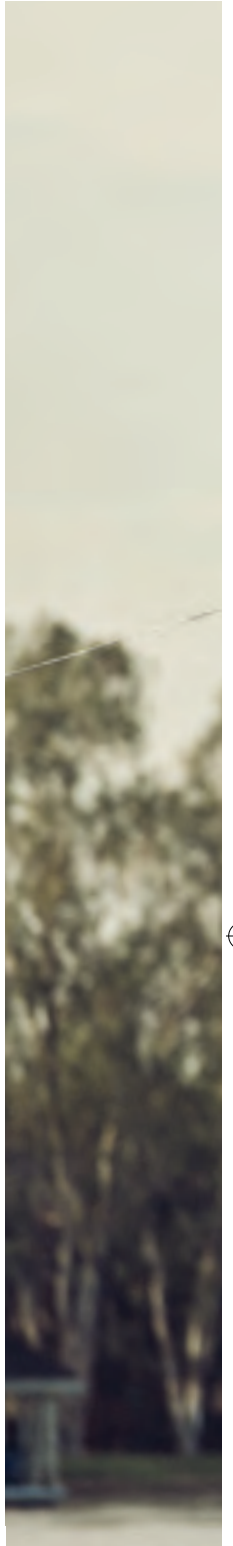

IMPORTANT

Please read the information below regarding entry qualifications and procedures for the 2015 GOODE Water Ski National Championships. Meeting entry qualifications and following the necessary procedures will determine whether or not you compete in the tournament. The contestant is responsible for meeting entry qualifications and providing proof of eligibility within the stated time limit.

QUALIFICATION

Entry qualification requirements are available in the 2015 AWSA Rulebook at USAWATERSKI.org.

ENTRY AND ENTRY DEADLINE

Online entry submission is required at USAWATERSKI.org. USA Water Ski must receive entries by 5 p.m. on Tuesday, Aug. 4, 2015, to avoid penalty. Late entries will be accepted at USA Water Ski until noon on Friday, Aug. 7, 2015, or by the Chief Registrar at the tournament site until 5 p.m. on the day prior to the scheduled start of the skier's first event. Entries submitted after the 5 p.m. Aug. 4 deadline must include a late fee of \$10.00 per 24-hour period or portion thereof. **ABSOLUTELY NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 5 P.M., THE DAY PRIOR TO THE SCHEDULED START OF THE SKIER'S FIRST EVENT. ABSOLUTELY NO FAX ENTRIES.** If you desire verification of receipt, please refer to the Registration Status Report at USAWATERSKI.org.

ENTRY FEES

1 Event: \$160; 2 or 3 Events: \$187; Family of 3 or More: \$425*

* Each participant must complete online registration.

REGISTRATION

All contestants must register at the National Tournament, either in person, by web registration at USAWATERSKI.org, or through a representative, providing all required proof of qualification and fees no later than one-half hour before the scheduled start of the contestant's first event. If the skier's registration on USAWATERSKI.org is incomplete or is NOT shown as qualified and fully paid in the online registration system, then they would need to present themselves at on-site Registration. On-site registration must occur within the allowable hours as listed below.

No competitor will be permitted to ski in the 2015 GOODE Water Ski National Championships tournament unless he or she has signed the Adult/Minor Specific Event Waiver. Signature of parent or guardian is required for a minor entering the tournament.

Registration hours will be from 10 a.m. until 5 p.m. on Monday, Aug. 10, 2015; from 45 minutes prior to the start of the first event until 5 p.m. on Tuesday, Aug. 11 through Friday, Aug. 14; and from 45 minutes prior to the start of the first event until 30 minutes prior to the start of the last event on Saturday, Aug. 15.

REFUND POLICY

\$35 of the entry fee (per person) is an administration and processing fee and is non-refundable. Late fees are also non-refundable. If you registered for the 2015 GOODE Water Ski National Championships and you are unable to participate, you must submit a cancellation request to USA Water Ski in writing or by email to usawaterski@usawaterski.org prior to the start of your first event. If you do not submit a cancellation request, you will not receive a refund. Cancellation requests will be honored due to lack of qualification or medical with documentation provided. All other excuses will be evaluated by the president of AWSA at the time the **cancellation notice is received to determine whether or not a refund will be issued. USA Water Ski will pay refunds within 60 days following the conclusion of Nationals.**

("USA Water Ski") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in the USA Water Ski sanctioned tournament, clinic, show, exhibition, race, competition, practice or other event described above (the "Event" or "Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, guardians, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Waiver and Release of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement (the "Agreement");

1. I hereby represent that (i) I am at least eighteen (18) years of age or older; (ii) I am in good health and in proper physical condition to participate in the Event; and (iii) I am not under the influence of alcohol or any illicit or prescription drugs which would in any way impair my ability to safely participate in the Event. I agree that it is my sole responsibility to determine whether I am sufficiently fit and healthy enough to participate in the Event, that I am responsible for my own safety and well being at all times and under all circumstances while at the Event site.
2. I understand and acknowledge the risks and dangers associated with participation in the sport of water skiing and related water sport disciplines, including without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury, sickness and disease, permanent disability, paralysis and loss of life; loss of or damage to equipment/property; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; contact with other participants, spectators, boats, animals or other natural or manmade objects; dangers arising from adverse weather conditions; imperfect ski course conditions; water and surface hazards; equipment failure; inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the Event Organizers; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks"). I understand that these Risks may be caused in whole or in part by my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the Event, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby expressly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses or expenses which I incur as a result of my participation in any Event.

The chart below lists the buoy count for a perfect pass for a given boat speed and line length for each division.

Example: A perfect pass for a skier in the Men 2 division at 13 meters and 58 kph is 96 total buoys.

The total buoy count for an imperfect pass can be determined by taking the total buoy score for the last perfect pass and adding the number of buoys scored on the imperfect pass.

Example: A Men 3, 4, 5 or 6 skier who makes 2½ buoys at 23 meters at 55 kph has a total buoy count of 62½ buoys (60 plus 2½ buoys).

USA Water Ski's Coaching Development Program was introduced in 1991 as a program that provides a structure for the certification of water ski instructors and coaches through a three-step process of education, participation and evaluation. The goal of the program is to improve the quality and consistency of water ski instruction in the United States.

Refer to the [Coaches Development Program Quantitative Requirements for Advancement and Renewal](#) for more information.

USA WATER SKI LEVEL 1 INSTRUCTOR (ages 18 and up): USA Water Ski provides training and certification for aspiring instructors and coaches to teach students the necessary skills to safely and successfully participate in the various USA Water Ski sport disciplines.

In an effort to ensure that USA Water Ski certified instructors and coaches are well versed in the importance of the health and safety of all students, especially minors, USA Water Ski requires all instructors and coaches to submit to and pass a Criminal Background Screening and participate in an online Child Abuse Prevention/Awareness Training program. The cost of the course is **\$70.00** or **\$110.00** if you elect to purchase the optional coaches liability insurance coverage. Please see below for more information on the three components of the Level 1 Instructor's Course.

Minimum Requirements:

- current USA Water Ski Active member (*does not include GrassRoots or Guest members*)
- age 18 or above
- valid social security number

Note: *Foreign instructors/coaches and those under the age of 18 are not eligible for this program.*

- 1) Criminal Background Screening:** This process includes the investigation and review of various consumer reports and law enforcement/public records including, but not limited to, the items listed below. Results are returned within, on average, three (3) business days.
 - Criminal History Check
 - Sex Offender Registry Check
 - Social Security Number Check
 - Address Checks
 - Employment Checks
 - Reference Checks
- 2) SafeSport Training:** This training, originally created by the U.S. Olympic Committee (USOC), and adapted by USA Water Ski, focuses on recognizing and reducing circumstances for potential abuse to occur, the availability and procedures for any person to report suspected abuse or misconduct (including protections from any retaliation or repercussions for such reporting) and procedures and means by which a coach should respond to allegations of abuse and misconduct. Upon completion of the training, you will be required to answer a series of 20 multiple choice or true/false questions. The test results are graded and presented immediately. **Passing = 90%**

- 1. Clinics** – Level 3 clinics must be conducted by a qualified course conductor (list available in the "Officials' Directory" under the "Officials' Resources" section of USA Water Ski's Web site).
- 2. Practical Experience** – All practical experience must be documented on a Personal Performance Record (distributed at Level 3 clinics and available on USA Water Ski's Web site under "Coaching Resources") by a ski school owner or camp/ clinic head instructor/coach.
- 3. Testing** – An aspiring Level 3 coach must take the written and video evaluations at a location arranged through a member of AWSA's National Coaching Advisory Committee from his region or USA Water Ski HQ. An aspiring Level 1 or 2 instructor is eligible to take the written test only twice during a calendar year. An aspiring Level 3 coach is eligible to test only once during a calendar year.

4. Criminal Background Screening – Instructors/Coaches must be 18 years of age or older and possess a valid social security number to be eligible for screening and subsequent certification.

5. Coaches Liability Insurance Program – USA Water Ski offers certified instructors/coaches who have completed the required Criminal Background Screening and SafeSport Training, the opportunity to purchase General Liability and Professional Liability insurance for their coaching activities. For more information, please refer to the "Insurance Resources" link on USA Water Ski's Web site.

6. Certification Renewal Requirements – Instructors/Coaches must maintain a USA Water Ski Active membership and successfully complete a Criminal Background Screening and SafeSport Training once every two (2) years. Current instructors/coaches may purchase the certification renewal by logging into their

"Members-Only" section of USA Water Ski's Web site using their membership number and password and clicking on the "Instructor/Coach Programs" link and selecting the "Purchase Instructor/Coach Certification Renewal" option.

Purchasing Courses and Liability Insurance – Active members may purchase the aforementioned items by logging into their "Members-Only" section of USA Water Ski's Web site using their membership number and password and clicking on the "Instructor/Coach Programs" link and selecting the applicable course.

Special Consideration – For information about being grandfathered through Levels 2 and 3, contact USA Water Ski.

Fast Track Options for Assistant/Senior Judge and Regular Driver – As an alternative to meeting all quantitative requirements, skiers who hold a specified rating on AWSA's National Rankings List are eligible to take advantage of "Fast Track" options to attain certain officials rating. Refer to the **AWSA Officials Development Program Description** for further details.

Three, Two or Single Event Ratings – An individual working toward rating upgrade must complete the quantitative requirements for each event for which he is seeking upgrade.

Multiple Officials Rating Credits – An individual is eligible to serve as a judge, scorer and/or driver at one tournament and receive more than one official's rating credit. However, only one credit is awarded per official's rating category (judge, scorer or driver) per tournament. For example, although an individual can be an Assistant Chief Judge and also judge one or more events at a tournament, he only receives one rating credit as Assistant Chief Judge or judge, not both, for that tournament.

Judging Credit – Judges will only receive upgrade and maintenance credit for work performed as Shore Judge, Boat Judge, Meter Reader or Master Board Operator (includes video jump operations).

Grassroots Tournaments – Slalom credit may be obtained for aspiring Assistant Judges working a Grassroots tournament. Full maintenance (not upgrade) credit is awarded to Chief Driver only at Grassroots events.

Regional Tournament Credit for Aspiring Senior Judges and Scorers – Credit may be obtained by work performed at either a Regional or National tournament, including work at both tournaments during the same year. The NCWSA All-Stars and Nationals shall not count toward fulfilling the quantitative requirement of Regional's attendance for upgrading to Senior. Under exceptional circumstances, an aspiring Senior Judge or Scorer may apply to the Judges and Scorers Committee for a one-time hardship to allow work at a Record tournament to be counted toward one of the Regional/National tournament credits required to upgrade.

Aspiring Senior Scorers – Aspiring Senior Scorers may reduce the number of non Regional/National tournaments required by serving as Chief Scorer more than the three minimum times. This experience will substitute for working two tournaments each time it is done, for a maximum of three times. Therefore, the aspiring Senior Scorer will have served as Chief Scorer for a minimum of three or a maximum of six countable times. This reduces the current requirement by up to three tournaments and provides more relevant experience.

Clinics – Clinic attendance is mandatory for upgrading all ratings. With the exception of Assistant Judges and Scorers, all officials must attend one (1) USA Water Ski-sanctioned clinic every four (4) years to renew their ratings. One clinic may be used in place of one tournament credit. At the beginning of each year, USA Water Ski will send e-mail notifications to officials who will be required to attend a clinic before the end of the calendar year.

Renewal Requirements

- For an individual to maintain a judge, scorer or driver rating, he must officiate in the number of tournaments indicated in the renewal column above for each event rated during a two calendar year period. Renewal requirements are reviewed at the end of every "odd" year for rating renewal for the next two-year period (i.e., January 1, 2012 to December 31, 2013 for renewal for 2014).
- Assistant officials who receive their rating in the "even" year, will only be required to meet half of the renewal requirements above. Assistant officials who receive their rating in the "odd" year are automatically renewed for the next two-year period. These Assistant officials will, however, be required to meet all renewal requirements for the next two-year period.
- Senior Drivers who hold a slalom rating must submit an end course video of their driving performance to their regional drivers' committee representative once a year for review.

Tracking Your Officials Credits for Upgrade/Renewal: An official can view the tournaments/clubs for which he receives officiating credit for both maintenance and upgrade purposes by logging into his "Members-Only" section of USA Water Ski's Web site using his membership number and password and clicking on **"My Officials Rating."** In the case of discrepancies, the official should contact the applicable Chief Official so that he may contact USA Water Ski and see that proper credit is issued.

PRE-SEASON SKIING WITH JIMMY SIEMERS

Get your season started off right by making and implementing specific fitness goals.



GET TO THE GYM

Work with a trainer if possible. You may be surprised by the gains you will make with a proper guidance.

PARTAKE IN ANOTHER SPORT

To correct imbalances and get your mind away from skiing, immerse yourself in another activity; preferable something with dynamic movement. I play tennis.

YOGA YOGA YOGA

Give it a shot, it's not as bad as you may think. It will increase your range of motion, flexibility and functional strength. It will pay off when it comes time to hit the water.

GET BACK TO THE WATER

Get back at it with basic skills and concepts. Spend a lot of time riding your skis focusing on the few keys that have proved to be the most beneficial. It's a long season, create a strong basic skill set early and reap the benefits later in the year.

DON'T OVER-TRAIN

It's important to recognize when your body needs rest to avoid injury. Keep your sets short, skiing only when you feel strong to avoid improper technique and early injury.

SLALOM TRUTHS WITH TRENT FINLAYSON

Regardless of your ability level, there are a few concrete truths that need to be the base of your technique and the end result of every technical aspect of your technique. This will help to clear your mind of much of the minutia and allow you to concentrate on what is truly important. Assess your skiing and ask yourself how does each of my movements contribute to the essential bottom line.



STRUCTURAL ALIGNMENT

This refers to your body's skeletal alignment. You need to be stacked, head over shoulders over hips over feet. This needs to be your goal before you make your first move on your gate pullout. The better your structural alignment, the stronger you will be in managing the load on the rope.

ROPE ALIGNMENT

Keeping your body's alignment in line with the rope is how you achieve that 'light on the line' feel, moving with the boat instead of struggling against it. This means that your hips and your feet should always be directly in line with the rope and handle, never swinging in front of the handle and never falling behind.



There are hundreds of different cues or tips that lend themselves to these two components. To keep from getting sidetracked with minor details however, always ask yourself how is this going to affect what is most important to my skiing.
